Rewilding Landscapes

Restoring native forests from riverwoods to mountain tops, with a focus on the Caledonian Pinewoods, bringing life back to the land.

This programme includes our pinewood landscape programme, wild trees and native tree seed collection, working closely with landowners to create balance, restore nature and enable it to take care of itself.

Supporting Missing Species

Creating the best possible conditions for the return of key wildlife such as red squirrels, beavers, lynx and tauros.


This programme focuses on those missing species that will help to shape the land, rivers and soil. By bringing back these key players in a truly connected landscape, we can create a diverse and thriving ecosystem that can flourish on a large scale.

Rewilding People

Empowering people through learning, engagement and community rewilding, and bringing communities closer to nature.

This programme ensures that the positive impacts of rewilding are felt by everyone, from every background. By encouraging active involvement, we can ensure that there is a deeper connection between people and the natural world.

Translocated over **200 red squirrels**, creating 12 new populations.



Welcomed **20,000+ visitors** in the first year of the Dundreggan Rewilding Centre.



Surveyed **70+ ancient pinewood fragments**, with supporting recommendations for expansion.



Engaged more than **5,000 volunteers** in rewilding, providing funded places for over 100 people from disadvantaged backgrounds



Secured a licence with FLS to **release beavers into Glen Affric** and launched a new project to consider the **Loch Ness area**.



Grown 80,000+ native trees annually at our tree nursery. Including specialist, rare species.



Published a 100-page report on the feasibility of **lynx reintroduction in Scotland**, the most comprehensive study to date..



Restored **500+ acres of peatland** at Dundreggan, our flagship estate.
